REGULATIONS FOR PROCESSING APPLICATIONS FOR RECIPROCAL ADMISSION ON MOTION

The Board has adopted the following regulations pursuant to Maine Bar Admission Rule 13 in order to administer its duties under Maine Bar Admission Rule 11A:

- 1. Unless otherwise extended as provided in (2) below, an application for reciprocal admission on motion pursuant to Maine Bar Admission Rule 11A expires if the applicant has not been sworn in to the Maine bar within twelve months after the date the Board receives the application.
- 2. An applicant may extend the expiration date of his/her application for an additional six months by submitting to the Board, prior to expiration, an extension form accompanied by a fee of \$100. The extension form shall be as prescribed by the Board. Only one such six-month extension is permitted.
- 3. An applicant who is not sworn in to the Maine bar prior to the expiration of his/her application and who wishes to re-apply for reciprocal admission on motion shall submit to the Board a new application accompanied by the usual new application fee.

These regulations are applicable to all applications submitted after May 1, 2012.
