

## CONCURRENT APPLICATIONS

### For Applicants Seeking Admission to Maine but Sitting for the July 2026 UBE Exam in Another Jurisdiction

1. Concurrent applicants must complete the appropriate Application (a. or b.) in the portal after reading the related instructions.
  - a. Applicants not admitted to any jurisdiction for one year or more
  - b. Applicants who are admitted in another jurisdiction for one year or more
  - c. If admitted in another jurisdiction for one year or more, concurrent applicants also must complete the NCBE Character and Fitness application for Maine and upload a copy of that application to your application in the portal.
  - d. If you have previously applied for admission to the Maine bar, please send a message in the portal for specific instructions.
2. Concurrent applicants must pay the appropriate application fee.
  - a. Applicants who are not admitted in any jurisdiction for one year or more; the fee is \$800.
  - b. Applicants who are admitted to another jurisdiction for one year or more; the fee is \$900.
  - c. Credit card links are available in the instructions and on the Upcoming Exam webpage. Checks, money orders or cashier's checks can be sent to our mailing address but must be **received** by May 20, 2026.
3. Concurrent applicants must notify the Maine Board of Bar Examiners through the application portal that you are applying for concurrent admission and identify the jurisdiction where you intend to take (sit for) the exam.
4. Concurrent applicants must provide all required Application Forms, academic documents, reference questionnaires, certificates of good standing if applicable, MPRE score, and any additional information required by the Board. The Exam Forms packet will not be required. See instructions for applicants not admitted to another jurisdiction for Required Documents details.
5. Concurrent applicants must adhere to the following deadlines:

May 20, 2026 at 5:00 for submission of the complete application in the portal, payment of the application fee, and upload of the Application Forms.

July 14, 2026 for submission of academic documents.

After results are released, transfer of your score and completion of your application (reference questionnaires, MPRE score, other documents required by the Board, etc.) are required before admission can be considered.
